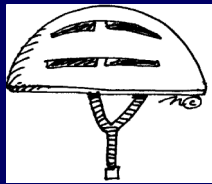


## Safety City for Kindergarten Students

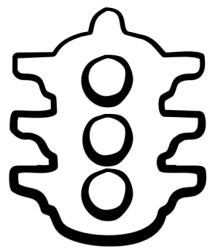
