

## Q3 How often do you use Lake Emily Park or Campground?






## Q7 How often do you use Lake Emily Park Campground?


## Q13 How often do you use Standing Rocks Park?









# Q75 How often do you use the Tomorrow River State Trail?(Any time of year.)








